PURCHASE OF SCHOOL UNIFORM and BOOKS POLICY

I - School Uniform

Al Adhwa Private School believes that a safe and disciplined learning environment is the first requirement of a high performing school. This includes the wearing of prescribed school uniform as suitable wear in the school. This policy is based on the notion that school uniform presents a professional image to our community wherever they are. It allows for identification of visitors on campus and encourages students to concentrate on learning rather than on what they are wearing.

The UAE Portal on Information and Services announced RE; "School Uniforms" which states among others that "uniform are compulsory for all school students in the UAE.

This school year 2022-2023, schools will be operating in its normal activities. Students will be attending classes face to face just like before. **Therefore, we encourage parents to purchase school uniform/s for their children.** These are available from KG 1 to Grade 12.

II - Purchase of Books

Books are very important tools in teaching and learning. These are practical and fundamental resources as means of information needed by the students in their learning. More significantly, books help to maintain high academic standards.

The school in its desire to continuously aspire for excellence in learning has purchased books according to the students' number who booked and reserved a seat for the new academic year (2022-2023).

This policy clearly states that:

- Photocopies of books and other learning materials are not allowed since this is against the copy rights law.
- For new students, purchase of books is compulsory regardless of whatever school or curriculum they have come from.
- Purchase of required books from grade 1 to 9 is compulsory.

- Some books for grade 9 can be used for grade 10, 11 and 12.
- Purchase of MOE books package (Grade 1-12) is compulsory and must be bought from the school.

Parents can purchase school uniform and books at our store located near the entrance of the school.
