

External Assessment Fees

Introduction

As part of the school's commitment to providing quality education and measuring student progress against international standards, students are required to participate in selected external assessments. These assessments help track academic growth, guide instruction, and support university and career readiness. Some of these assessments carry additional costs that are charged separately from regular tuition fees. The fees are communicated in advance and are subject to the regulations set by the respective assessment providers.

NWEA MAP (Measures of Academic Progress)

The NWEA Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) is an internationally recognized, computer-adaptive assessment designed to measure students' academic progress in core subjects—Mathematics, Reading, and Language Usage. This test is mandatory for all students from Grades 3 to 9, in compliance with ADEK requirements.

The MAP assessment is conducted twice per academic year—once in the Fall Term and again in the Spring Term—to track student growth over time and inform instruction. The cost of the NWEA MAP is included in the school's tuition fees and is non-refundable once the testing cycle begins.

AP College Board (Advanced Placement)

Advanced Placement (AP) assessments are standardized exams administered by the College Board, allowing students to earn college credit and demonstrate readiness for university-level coursework. These exams are optional but highly recommended for eligible high school students from Grades 10-12 pursuing academic excellence and international university admissions. Each AP exam carries a separate fee, which is determined annually by the College Board.
